



# WMAC Event Traffic Management and Officials' Procedures (CovidSafe) – Level 1 (Feb 2021)

(to be updated to be relevant State/National Health requirements)

## 1. Door Entry management

- a. All athletes and ticket holders (spectators) are to line up with social distancing (1.5 metres) to enter the venue
- b. All athletes and spectators must have registered online and have online purchased ticket (spectators) present to be allowed entry.
- c. No limit to Spectators for each athlete, however ticket sales will close once venue capacity is achieved (first in best dressed).
- d. No access without a prior registered ticket
- e. Junior only athletes (sub 17 years) will be allowed in the venue (with accompanying adult) between 8.00am – 11.30am
- f. Adult only athletes (17 years and above) will be allowed to enter the venue from 11.30am only, not prior to this time allocation
- g. Once each athlete has completed their own division(s), they will be requested to leave the venue with their accompanying spectator ticket holders
  - i. This will allow for AMAC to strictly control the capacity of the venue throughout the day and adhere to Covid Safe requirements
- h. Every athlete will receive a program (via email 2 days prior to the competition date) of when (times) their division(s) is scheduled for the day. Athletes are requested to enter the venue approximately 1 hour prior to their division scheduled times, but not more than 1 hour.
  - i. This will allow for AMAC to strictly control the capacity of the venue throughout the day and adhere to Covid Safe requirements

## 2. Door Registration Management

- a. Door Staff
  - i. Wear Gloves and Masks
  - ii. Social distancing 1.5m from each other and patrons
  - iii. Contactless tickets pre-purchased – no cash handling

## 3. Floor management

- a. Floor Staff – judges, referees, table officials and runners
  - i. Table officials and runners to may wear gloves and face mask optional (non-contact with the public)
  - ii. Judges and referees may wear gloves and can use of whistle with a face mask.
  - iii. Judges and referees will be stationary whilst judging and will move only from outside the matted area – to practice social distancing with athletes and with each other

## 4. Athlete requirements and management

- a. Only competing athletes on the matted area
- b. The next athlete to compete to be ready on the side of the matted area

- c. All other athletes to sit away from the matted area and 1.5m from each other (social distancing requirements to be observed)
  - d. No sharing of equipment allowed
  - e. No requirement of 'Kiai' (martial arts shout or heavy breathing) during competition to minimise any droplets being discharged
  - f. No requirement of handshakes, hugs or huddles (social distancing requirements to be observed)
  - g. Once the athlete has completed all their divisions in the competition they will be asked to leave the venue along with their accompanying spectator
  - h. All athletes are asked not to use change rooms and come changed for competition and leave in their competition attire
5. Toilets and change rooms
    - a. All attendees inside the venue are asked not to use changerooms and facilities and come prepared for their day and leave as they are.
    - b. For toilets – all will be asked to observe social distancing and practice hygiene
  6. All floors staff – bump in and bump out will be require the same hygiene and distancing requirements to be observed as with all other parties within the event
  7. Any breeches will be reported to venue management
  8. Any CovidSafe notifications of possible and actual infections will be reported to the State Health authorities and venue management within 24 hrs being made of aware of the said infection or reported infection.
  9. Any change to this Covid Safety Plan will be submitted for approval and notation to the relevant venue management and health authorities required.
